

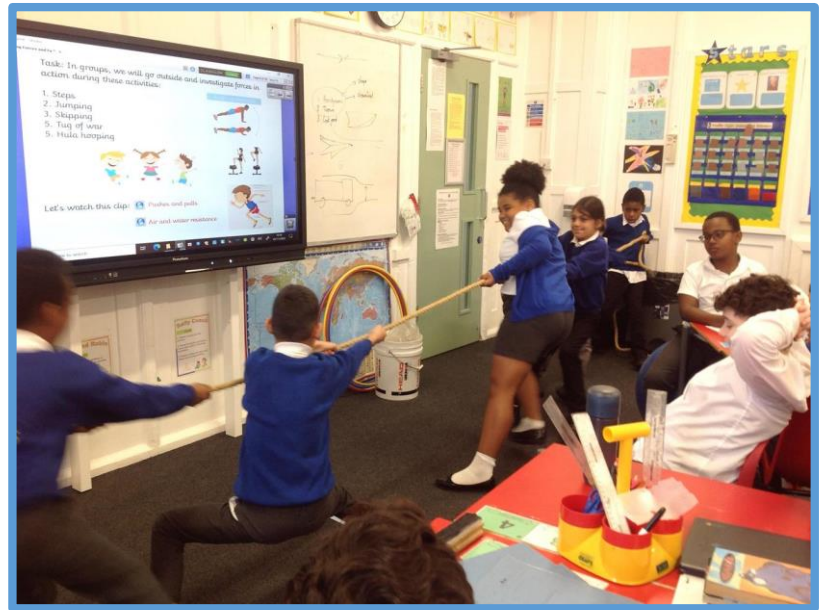
# Griffin Class End of Year Update
